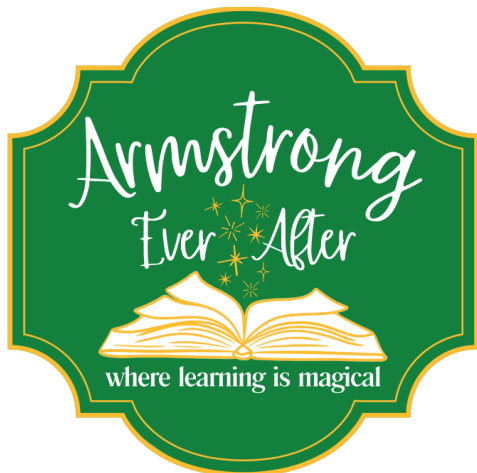

Armstrong TAG testing for registered students will take place the week of **January 29–February 6**. Testing sessions are scheduled across multiple rooms on campus and coordinated to meet students' individual needs, so we cannot provide specific dates or times for families.

What to expect:

- Testing will be administered during the school day; students will be pulled from their classroom for their session.
- Students will not be tested during their scheduled lunch.
- Testing will occur in several different classrooms across campus, so you may notice increased movement throughout the day.
- Sessions vary in length depending on the assessment; students will return to their regular classes when finished.

How you can help:

- Ensure your child arrives at school on time and is well-rested.
- Avoid scheduling appointments during the school day that week.
- Send a healthy snack if your child typically needs one during the school day.
