

Dear Armstrong Families,

In accordance with Texas Senate Bill 12, HPISD is required to collect annual parent consent for routine school-based health and counseling services. These services, provided by nurses, athletic trainers, and counselors, have not changed—only the requirement for yearly consent is new.

To complete the form, log in to Skyward Family Access, open "25-26 HPISD Notification & Consent for Services," and indicate your consent for each child. For details, visit https://parentalConsent.

In addition, please note that we will be conducting state mandated health screenings (hearing, vision and acanthosis nigricans) on September 24, 2025 for all students in Kindergarten, 1st grade, 3rd grade and 4 year old preschool students.
