Our Book Fair is in full swing, so I hope you have had time to support our library. Thanks to our amazing librarian, Lori Riley, and our PTA and Dads Club Volunteers for working hard to ensure we have a successful book fair!

As part of our commitment to supporting students to become successful readers through developing foundational literacy skills, we use DIBELS (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills, 8th ed.) as a beginning and end of year assessment of literacy skills. Our K-2 students recently completed the beginning of year assessment window, and score reports are available in the Skyward Portfolio for parents to review. The report describes measures used to determine student proficiency and what parents can do to help develop these literacy skills. Please contact your student's teacher if you have additional questions.






Armstrong Yearbook: we want your photos for the 2024-25 Armstrong Eagles Yearbook!
