Our students in grades 1-4 completed the beginning of year MAP Growth Math and Reading assessment. The results of this assessment are now available in Skyward. Our students performed exceptionally well in both math and reading. If you have not previously accessed MAP scores in Skyward, the link below has guided directions to help.

Accessing MAP Scores through Skyward

MAP Growth scores are only one data point that teachers use to determine how a student is performing so they can best plan for instruction for each student. Based on all data collected, your child's teacher is happy to answer any questions and will communicate further information throughout the semester.

We believe this assessment is an effective measure since it provides very detailed information in math and reading which helps us plan and differentiate our daily instruction for your child.
